Dear Parent,

Greetings from VDJS!

1. Hope this mail finds you and your family in the best of health and wellness. It has been a long time since the students have been away from campus due to the unprecedented pandemic that disrupted everyone across the globe.
2. We are aware that the virus has not been eliminated and nor has the vaccine being produced, yet it is pertinent that within the norms of safety and security we open up our operations to gradually resume normalcy following the guidelines issued by the Health Ministry and Haryana State Government.
3. During the period of lock down we have conducted several virtual PTMs and surveys to seek your feedback and opinion on the matters pertaining to functioning of the school. Your constructive feedback and appreciation have been a constant source of motivation for the VDJS team.
4. As you are aware that the Government of Haryana has permitted to open the schools in the state from 15 October 2020 for Classes IX to XII with the condition that the students will report to school with the written consent of the parents, and the schools will continue to provide online classes while they open up the gates of the school to welcome students back on campus.
5. In our attempt to move a step forward to unlock the system, we recently conducted a survey to know your views on sending your daughter to school and we thank you for your valuable feedback. Please find attached the report of the survey for your ready reference.
6. In view of the consent of the parents, VDJS has decided to open the school campus for the students around **20 November 2020** as around 30% of the parents have shown their willingness to send their daughters to school.
7. Those who are still not confident sending their children to school their daughters will continue with online classes.
8. As per our COVID Mitigation plan, and to ensure utmost safety and security of our students, once the students will be on campus, there will be no further travel permitted till the end of the academic session in March 2021.
9. Visits of parents and visitors to school will be restricted, and the school will continue to be in contact with the parents through Virtual Parent Teacher Meet and via mentors WhatsApp groups.
10. Parents of Classes IX to XII are requested to drop their wards on 20 November 2020 latest by 05.00 p.m.
11. **In keeping with our COVID mitigation plan, a questionnaire is attached herewith. Parents are requested to dully fill up the questionnaire and get it along when reporting to school. Further, all students need to carry with them a COVID negative test report when reporting to school. Students travelling under school escorted travel from New Delhi airport are required to scan and email their CoViD test report a day prior to departure. In the event of a student arriving without a CoViD negative test report, she will not be permitted to travel under school escort. The test report date should be 19 November 2020 for students reporting to school on 20 November 2020.**

12. The School will arrange school escorted travel from Delhi Airport to the School. Parents wishing to avail of this facility may book air-tickets for their ward as per the following details and furnish the flight details along with the undertaking (ref. Annexure 'A') to school latest by **10 November 2020** so that necessary transit arrangements can be made.

Important Instructions regarding Air Travel Arrangements.

- a) Purchase of Air-ticket should be as per the name, surname & spelling in the School Identity Card.
- b) Kindly adhere to above said timings of arrival; school escort team will be responsible only for the students arriving within the given time slot.
- c) Conduct of the student during the journey should be good.
- d) Only 01 Suitcase (18 inch) and 01 Handbag are allowed. Baggage of the students should be labelled for easy identification and trans-shipment.
- e) Student should be in the School Sweatshirt & carry School Identity Card.
- f) **Student should wear face mask, shield, gloves and carry hand sanitizer throughout the journey.**
- g) **Student should carry with her some homemade packed dry eatables for herself during the journey. No student is permitted to stop at any of the food joints and shops at the airport. No purchases to be made on the way.**
- h) **Students must come out of the airport straight after collecting their baggage from the belt.**
- i) In case the student does not find a staff member of the school; she should wait at the designated place until the arrival of the staff member.
- j) All students travelling by air will carry their official mobile phones during the journey. **Please ensure that Arogya Setu App is installed on their mobile phones.**
- k) Students travelling by international flights are permitted to carry their personal mobile phones. **Please ensure that Arogya Setu App is installed on their mobile phones.** They are required to deposit their mobile phones with their Dorm Parents on the day of arrival at VDJS.
